## **Oral Sessions (All Papers & Abstract Only)**

This will be a conventional lectern presentation to the general assembly of delegates during one of the conference sessions. The expected presentation times will be followed by question time.

There will be an emphasis on generating healthy discussion and debate. Presenters will be encouraged to lead this discussion by highlighting key issues during their presentations and prepare topics for debate e.g. next steps.

Presentations should have good structure with a clear message and the key points outlined in the introduction. Something unique or engaging in the presentation will make the delivery memorable and hold the attention of the audience.

## **Interactive Poster Sessions (All Papers & Abstract Only)**

This session provides for an interactive discussion through a two-stage presentation including a short 2-minute pitch followed by a time for the audience to interact with the presenter. Up to two slides to summarise your work may be displayed during your presentation.

Presenters are encouraged to add to their discussion following the quick pitch, by incorporating tools, audio, visual and tactile aids (if using VR or technological aids, please indicate this in the presentation portal when loading your abstract. At this stage, the conference is unable to provide these). Presenters must be available beside each display to provide details and answer questions.

## **The Learning Cafe (All Papers & Abstract Only)**

Presenter shares ideas or poses questions to a small group sitting at a table with them. Every 15 minutes, attendees switch tables, and the presentation starts again with a new group at the table. The typical length for the session is 60 minutes (attendees can go to 4 presentations). Generally, 5-10 people at the table. The initial presentation is 5 minutes long with 10 mins being allowed for Q&A and discussion.

## **Soapbox (All Papers & Abstract Only)**

This format allows the presenter 8 minutes to have their ideas heard. This format will work well for Think Piece papers and Abstract Only submissions.

Challenging views are encouraged and could also include the sharing of any projects that are likely to be of interest to the audience. Q&A will follow at the end of the session.
